Robert Miertschin ginner at Grassyville was a business caller at the News office Monday and remarked that it was the first time he had been to town since the ginning season had opened. He had ginned 592 bales to date and will gin considerably over 600 bales this year against 515 for last year. This is the best ginning season at Grassyville in 10 years, and with the good price of the fleecy staple, the Grassyville farmers are in good financial condition.

The farms about Grassyville are mostly black upland and the crop matured early, so the season will soon close there.
