**LEE COUNTY RURAL
LIBRARY EXPANDING**

Mrs. Ella Lee Moore, assistant librarian of the Lee County Rural (Circulating) Library, reports 892 books circulating in schools participating during the month of January, and the number of books in library now number 1,122. The nucleus of this library was 57 books owned by the teachers of the county and known as the Teachers Library in 1922. In 1938 the teachers pooled these books at the county superintendent's office and with WPA assistance it became known as the Lee County Rural School (Circulating) Library.
