**TWO GAVE BOND IN
BANK ROBBERY CHARGE**

Two men were arrested in Houston Friday of last week on the charge of robbing the bank at Lexington the night of Feb. 10. They were brought to Giddings where they gave bond in the amount of \$2,000 each. Jimmy Yoast gave bond Tuesday, and R. C. Mauldin gave bond Thursday. They were carrying \$944 when arrested, and it was reported that \$45 of this was in nickels and dimes in a money bag. Warrants for their arrest in Houston were sworn out in Giddings Friday night by a deputy sheriff of Houston before Justice of the Peace Aug. Peter. Sheriff Burttschell has been spending some time tracing some gold pieces that were offered for change and for purchases at filling stations. A considerable amount of gold was taken from the Lexington bank when \$7,100 was taken.
