BANK ROBBERY

LAID TO FOUR

Looting of Lexington Institution Results in Charges

Austin, Texas, Dec. 7.—Four men were charged with robbery here Sunday in connection with the looting of the Lexington (Lee Cdunty) State Bank last Feb. 10.

Details of the robbery were cleared by Ranger Captain' Frank Hamer after he han been at work on the case several days.

Those charged were Milton McGregor, former cashier of the bank; William Dungan, Louis Grant and Earl Riggs, McGregor was arrested in Houston, Dungan in Brenham, Grant in San Marcos and Riggs in Lexington. Three of them made statements to Captain Hamer.

The bank's loss amounted to \$10,383, including eleven \$50 Liberty bonds which were burned in a tourist camp near Temple, Captain Hamer said the men told him.

Captain Hamer said the time lock of the bank vault was set so it would unboit itself at 3:30 a.m. Two of the men entered the bank at that hour and had ready access to the funds, he said.—Dallas News,
