**Reserves Organize  
At Lexington**

Reserve unit at Lexington has started off in a big way according to a report from Robert L. Phillips of Tanglewood.

All members of Co. H. 357 Infantry Regiment, 2nd Bn., 90th Division, have been present for the past two training nights and new recruits have been steadily coming into the company. Headquarters is over the Post Office in Lexington. Most of the training sessions will be held there.

Uniforms will be issued soon for drill as well as other equipment for summer camp. Any ex-serviceman who wants to join the reserves is asked to contact Supt. Marshall Ashley of Lexington. Other men who have had no previous military service and who are 18 years of age and physically fit may join the unit.

Reserves receive pay for each training session they attend as well as points for retirement, Mr. Phillips reports.
