

Lone Star Gas Co. Says No Gas Now For Lexington

T. W. Simmons, president of the Lexington Chamber of Commerce, received a letter this week from the Lone Star Gas Company at Dallas, indicating that there is no immediate hope for natural gas to be piped into Lexington.

The letter, signed by A. P. Rowland, division superintendent, states that a survey just completed of the area indicated that not enough demand for their product existed at this time to justify the construction of a distribution system for Lexington.

Mr. Rowland added that the company was hopeful that it would be possible to consider piping natural gas to Lexington sometime in the future.
