Wm. Rackel proprietor of the gin at Lincoln was a business caller at the News office Monday. He has ginned 600 bales of cotton, against 532 for last year. Mr. Rackel thinks he will gin at least 100 bales more this season. This year is the best gin season in ten years for the Lincoln gin. Much of the cotton about Lincoln is in the bottoms and it is late in opening which is extending the season somewhat.
