BAD FIRE AT MANOR

Fire destroyed two blocks of buildings in Manor last Saturday night at 10:30, with a damage of possibly \$75,000 to buildings and stocks of merchandise. Four brick buildings and several frame buildings were completely destroyed on both sides of the street through the place. The fire broke out in a vacant shack and was checked by the Austin fire department bringing apparatus.
