It is time to start planting

annuals out of doors. Turn the flower beds to a depth of ten inches with a spading fork. Annuals such as, larkspur, poppy, bachelor's button, cornflower, and centaury can be sowed on unprepared ground. Some annuals do not take very kindly

to transplanting. Along highways and in the fields the annuals bloom from early spring until they are killed by a frost.
