## Promotional Exercises and School Closing At Serbin, Texas

Next Sunday afternoon the annual school closing and graduation program will be given. The program, which is to be rendered in the school, will begin at three o'clock. The following sixteen seventh grade pupils will graduate: Arnold Krause, Delbert Gersch, Ludwig Medack, Clarence Mutscher, Alvin Kessel, Junior Kubsch, Milton Kasper; Ellen Malke, Gladys Oltman, Tusneida Dunk, Gertrude Groeschel, Hedwig Mertink, Phillis Schmidt, Florence Urban, Florence Driessner, Bessie Schulz.

This will be the twentieth class in the history of the school to graduate from St. Paul's school. The total number of graduates of the twenty years is 167.

Primary and intermediate departments will give the first part of the program, made up of recitations, musical numbers, and little plays. The graduates will present the commencement exercises.

There will also be on display a school exhibit consisting of maps, drawings, diagrams, etc., by graduates of this as well as of past years. Some of the exhibits by graduates of former years will show work done in the Giddings high school, or in various other schools of higher learning, e. g. Texas Lutheran College at Seguin, Business College in Austin, Business College in Houston, Texas University in Austin, and various other colleges. There will also be on display charts, maps, diagrams, etc., prepared by some of the former graduates employed at this time in various departments of the government. The Radio and Broadcasting Department of the U. S. Army, Corps of Engineers of the War Department at Natches, Mississippi, the Weather Bureau at Abilene, Texas. The exhibits will be open for inspection in the school building on Sunday and also on Tuesday. On the later date the annual school picnic and barbecue will take place near the church at Serbin.
