

German Student To Speak at Serbin

Aki Beyer, a Lutheran student from Germany now studying at Texas University, will give an address and answer questions put to him concerning the church and state in Germany, on Nov. 5, 7:30 p. m., in the Serbin Church, the Rev. A. Arndt, pastor.

Mr. Beyer is being sponsored by Gamma Delta, the Lutheran Youth organization at Texas U, while here in America. The public is cordially invited to come and hear him. There will be a free-will offering.

Mr. Beyer is an exchange student. He has been in America only 6 weeks. He is taking 18 hours of work at the University, 9 hours being the average undertaken by most undergraduate students.

He was surprised to find that there is such a large class of average Americans, having been told by authorities behind the Iron Curtain that in America everyone is either a millionaire or a low-class beggar.
