NEWSPAPER CLOSED OUT

A newspaper published at Taylor in the German language by two partners, one of whom formerly lived in Giddings, has been closed along with the job printing shop by order of the government. Charges have been filed against the proprietors to cancel their U. S. Citizenship Papers for which they must stand trial.

The printing shop has been placed under guard day and night and not even a sheet of paper is permitted to be removed. The proprietors have been given a certain time to dispose of the equipment and if same is not complied with, the government will place it in storage.
