

**THORNDALE'S SECOND
TEST BEGINS.**

Thorndale, Tex., March 29. — All machinery and equipment of the Bremond-Ranch Syndicate is now on the ground and work on the new deep test well three miles southeast of Thorndale will begin at once. This company is composed of oil men of large experience and capital from Annapolis. This is the second deep test near Thorndale. The first was sunk one mile east of the city and went to a depth of 3,000 feet, where a strong flow of hot sulphur water rivaling the wells at Marlin and Kenedy and San Antonio, was struck, necessitating the abandonment of the well. This test was made a year ago. The well is still flowing about 2,000 barrels a day and has a temperature of 132 degrees.
