Dear Mr. Proske!

I confirm the receipt of your letter of February 14, 1921 including \$9.00 in American cash. I thank you very much for this gift for our foster children. We will use this money for the purchase of underwear for the orphans in the orphanage called Bergfrieden. The results of the war are among other things that the boys do not have sleeves in their shirts. Everything they wear is repaired. I was able to exchange the \$9.00 for 522 Marks equaling 58 Marks for each dollar. Thanks for sending the newspaper. I received #11 and #13, in addition two letter heads.
