Staff Sergeant Baker was the rear gunner aboard U.S. Army Air Corps B-29 Superfortress #42-63458 "Wing Ding." He perished when the bomber crashed on takeoff from the airbase at Dudhkundi in India. With the 444th Bomb Group, 676th Bomb Squadron.


