Louis was the oldest son of Herman T. Bernstein & Emma Marie Jentho Bernstein Born March 3, 1917 in Shackelford County, Texas. Was in the U.S. Army WWII, stepped on a land mine and was killed March 4, 1945, buried in U.S. Military Cemetery in Belgium. He was one of nine children. Father, Herman, died 7-21-1935 and was a brother to my father, Alvin. At Louis' suggestion widow Emma moved to Long Beach, California with her 8 children shortly before Louis was killed. He said the older children could get jobs in the factories out there.
