**C. W. KRAUSS TO
CAMP SWIFT**

Carlie Krauss began his duties as fire-truck driver at Camp Swift this week. He will be in charge of one of the four pieces of equipment in the camp area and will be on and off duty which will permit him to continue to live in Giddings. The camp is well supplied with fire hydrants and paved streets over the building site and Carlie will be like a duck in water.

He has driven the fire truck for the Giddings Volunteer Fire Department since 1925 without an accident of any kind and he has put the pumper down the highways at the rate of a mile a minute on the way to country fires. Fighting fires must be in the Krauss blood as Carlie's dad F. L. Krauss was Fire Chief in Giddings for more than thirty years.
