**WILL PARTICIPATE
IN ARMY EXERCISE**

Cpl. E. M. Schwartz, son of Mr. and Mrs. V. O. Schwartz, Lexington, is among 26,000 soldiers slated to participate in Exercise Apple Jack during May at the Yakima Firing Center near Fort Lewis, Wash.

Apple Jack will test the efficiency of infantry and support units in mountainous and desert terrain. The simulated use of atomic weapons will be one of

the conditions of the exercise.

Corporal Schwartz, who entered the Army in April 1953, is regularly stationed at Fort Lewis Wash., as a squad leader in Company M of the 2nd Infantry Division's 23rd Regiment.
