SENATORIAL VOTE

Incomplete returns from over Texas give the following vote:
For Senator:

O'Daniel 470,317
Allred 311,358
Moody 177,019

There are 4,000 votes yet to come in. The total vote so far was 971,210. O'Daniel's percentage was 48.42 and that means he and Allred will enter the run-off August 22, 1942. Should O'Daniel's percentage reach more than 50 percent, he would be nominated without a run-off.

STATE OFFICERS IN RUN-OFF

State Treasurer Jesse James (405,079) will probably face a run-off with W. Gregory Hatcher (172,624) of Dallas.

For Lieutenant Governor J. L. Smith (182,207) and Beck (146,423) will face each other.

For Railroad Commissioner Brooks (218,075) and Jester (158,610) will run for the unexpired term.

The 4,000 outstanding votes will hardly change these run-offs.
