Immigrated with MR. & MRS. Martin Budarick Sr.
The younger MR. & MRS. Budarick settled first in Wilberforce Twp.
They moved to Raglan Twp. c. 1870. Land still occupied
(as of 1983) by descendant, Daniel Budarick.
Immigrants — BURIED EVANGELICAL CHURCH, PALMER RAPIDS.

Originally Martin Budarick Sr. and Martin Budarick Jr. settled on adjacent
lots in 1858 in Wilberforce Twp. ~~in 1858~~ land would have to be
purchased at that time — no Free Grants in this township.
By Oct. 1860 the older man's property had ~~to~~ 36 acres cleared
and was growing wheat, peas, oats, barley, potatoes & flax. He had
2 cows, 2 oxen, 4 young cattle, 5 sheep, 4 pigs & 30 hens.
Little work had been done on the younger man's property,
only 10 acres cleared, so probably the family combined efforts.
