Wichita County Extension Agent David Graf recently received the Distinguished Service Award from the National Association of County Agriculture Agents

during the 2020 Annual Meeting and Professional Improvement Conference.

Graf was one of several honorees who represent the top two percent of the membership selected by their peers and the Director of Extension. Graf has been an extension agricultural agent for a total of 12 years. He has served in Texas counties of Sherman, Swisher, and currently in Wichita.

His key program areas have been in wheat, cotton, beef cattle, forage and horticulture. His result demonstrations have been part of state projects in capacitance probes, Khaki weed, and quail.

Graf works with 4-H, especially livestock projects and is working with 8 rainwater gardens for the underserved.
