

Herbert G. Liberty Received M. D. Degree

Mrsrs. Ben Liberty, Sr., August Berger and Paul Berger attended the 63. Commencement at Galveston Friday evening June 5 which was held in the Municipal Pier Auditorium.

188 were candidates for graduation that evening.

Herbert G. Liberty was one of the 138 candidates who graduated from the University of Texas Medical Branch and received his M. D. degree.
