**Colored Demonstration
for Lee County**

H. S. Estelle (colored) district agent for the county extension work over the state was in Giddings this week and gave us the information that at a competitive examination held under Prof. T. O. Walton of the A. & M. College there were eighteen applicants and that A. M. Mason made the highest mark of any applicant. He was selected as demonstrator for Lee County which position was created at a recent session of the commissioners court of this county. Mason has been principal of the Giddings colored school for the past fourteen
