**FARMERS MAKE ROOM
FOR ARMY CAMP**

Mr. George Mobley of Paige whose farms are in the Camp Swift site was in Giddings this week prospecting for a new home. His property near the Ridgeway cemetery west of Paige was included in the camp area and all farmers are expected to vacate by June 1. The government is settling with the property owners and they will move to other locations. The boundary line comes as far as the Ridgeway cemetery, then goes north to follow a new proposed highway to connect the Paige "Y" with McDade. The camp site will extend along the Paige-Bastrop highway for several miles. The Oak Hill cemetery site will be retained and the government will maintain it. The cemetery is within the camp site.
