

Spitzenberger Heads Committee To Plan Firemen's Softball League

The Giddings Volunteer Fire Department began preparations for sponsoring the Men's Softball League this summer at their monthly meeting last week.

Paul Spitzenberger and Hy. Bage were appointed to serve on the committee making the arrangements.

So far only the Fire Department has definitely decided to sponsor a team in the league. Other possibilities mentioned are the Walther League and the LCRE, both of whom fielded strong teams last year.

It is hoped that at least six

teams will be entered, but preferably a league with eight teams so that no team would be required to play two games in one week.

Mr. Spitzenberger stated that in addition to the regular men's league it was hoped that other individuals would group themselves into teams and match games on nights not set aside for league play.

He pointed out that the Fire Department built the playground and the Catholic Church provided the field with the standing that it is available to all who desired to use it for recreational purposes.

It is hoped that some junior teams as well as women's and girl's teams will make use of the facilities.
