La Grange junior Missy Zoch struck out nine players and allowed no hits over four innings in a 15-0 win over Navasota on Saturday. The DePaul recruit improved to 15-0 this season, and the victory was also her 47th straight conquest.

Zoch has yet to lose a game in her varsity career. Zoch picked up a win during her sophomore season, and her 31-0 record fueled La Grange's run to a Class 3A title in 2014.

According to the National Federation of State High School Associations, Zoch is one win shy of a tie for 11th place on the country's list for consecutive wins.

Candice Carnahan, who pitched in Louisiana from 1988-91, holds the all-time record of 107 consecutive wins, and that mark may be out of reach for Zoch. Michele Broussard, another Louisiana pitcher, sits in second place with 88 straight victories.
