Mrs. Elton Zoch Is Hurt in Auto Accident in Giddings Last Thursday

Mrs. Elton Zoch suffered a fractured leg Wednesday afternoon when the 1953 Ford she was driving was in collision with a truck on Highway 290 at Schneider Oldsmobile Co.

Mrs. Zoch was taken to Lee Memorial Hospital for treatment. Other occupants of the Zoch car were Mrs. Herbert Michalk, Miss

Lillian Zoch, and Gwendolyn Zoch, daughter of Mrs. Zoch. Mrs. Michalk sustained an arm bruise. Others were not hurt.

A charge of improper left turn was filed by the State Highway Patrol against Artie Pizkens of Waco, driver of the truck which belonged to Joe L. Ward and Co. of Waco. Pizkens was hauling mixed freight in the truck and was making a left turn across the highway when the collision occurred. The Zoch car was traveling east on the highway.

Front end of the Ford was damaged considerably. The 1954 Chevrolet truck was damaged only slightly.
