A Wendish Movement

In the free state of Saxony a movement has been started by the 25,000 Wends who still live there which encourages the support of the Slav heritage and cultural education. The Wends have joined the small group of Saxon Central Party with one voice in the Representative Assembly. They demand the introduction of the Wendish language in schools located in their areas, the training of teachers in the Wendish language, the founding of an all Wend school to 10th grade as well as a reporter in the Ministry of the Interior. We cannot assume that the government of Saxony will consider these various requests as they would demand huge cost.
