GOLDEN WEDDING ANNIVERSARY OBSERVED

LONG-TIME RESIDENTS CELEBRATED SUNDAY

Mr. and Mrs. Joseph E. Kubena celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary at Dime Box Sunday when many friends gathered at 3 p. m. for the occasion in response to invitations. A delicious spread was prepared in the yard when weather conditions were ideal, dry, clear and cool, with even the sunlight shaded by a few clouds. Fifty-six persons were seated at the table at each serving, and at least four tables were served for the dinner. Guests from far and near enjoyed the afternoon together and at night a yet larger crowd gathered at the hall where a big dance held sway until midnight. Mr. and Mrs. Kubena were the center of all activities and were as gay as any of the younger set. Mrs. Kubena showed her wedding dress, which was in perfect condition. It is of black silk made in basque style just as they are being worn today. She carried her black silk handkerchief which she used on her wedding day. She says that she did not prefer black color, but has found out that it brought her no bad luck.

Rosa Blaha was born March 10, 1869 at Hovezi, Moravia, Czecho-Slovakia, and came to America with her parents at the age of four years, was confirmed at Fayetteville, Texas in the Moravian Church. Mr. Kubena came to America at the age of four years with his parents to Shelby and grew up in the Catholic Church. They now both bellong to the Czech Moravian Brethren Church.

They were married in the New Tabor church, Burleson County, Nov. 15, 1891 at 11 a. m. by Rev. Juren. They began housekeeping on Dime Box prairie where they have lived the past fifty years. Three persons who attended the wedding, J. L. Kocurek (barefooted boy), L. J. Kocurek and Mrs. Albert Schuhmann were present Sunday. He bought a farm, then in 1909 a farm and gin which he operated fifteen years. He then sold out, retired and moved to Dime Box.

The orchestra played as the guests marched to the supper table. Mr. Vince Marek, Sr. made a congratulation talk and a granddaughter Miss Esther Kubena presented a gift with a congratulation speech.
