Mrs. Marvin Mitschke presided over the bride's book.

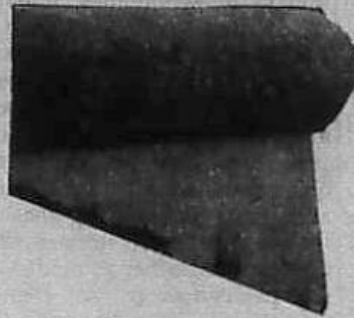
Those serving barbecue and all the trimmings were Mesdames Johnnie Nimtz, Ernest
