Old Fashioned Wedding

An old fashioned wedding took place in the Fedor community last week when Miss Martha Drosche daughter of August Drosche and wife, became the wife of Henry Urban, also of Fedor. In preparing for the occasion there were slaughtered:

20 chickens,

4 turkeys,

2 hogs,

1 beef,

and there was used:

58 cakes,

34 pies,

75 loaves of bread and other goodthings to egt.

There were 130 guests present and the feast lasted two days. The old fashioned weddings of Lee County generally lasted from one to three days, because they were used for assembling of the many friends and relatives, many of whom would come a long distance overland, and the guests had not seen each other for a long time. Therefore they were in no hurry to depart under two and generally three days.
