With the 7th Infantry Division In Korea

Pvt. Freddie C. Mitschke, son of Mr. and Mrs. Martin Mitschke of Winchester, recently arrived in Korea and is serving with the 7th Infantry Division.

Since making the amphibious landing at Inchon in the fall of 1950, the 7th has seen action in every sector of the Korean fighting.

World War II veterans will remember this same division

joined in the assault landing on Okinawa in April 1945 and drove from the west to the east coast on the first day. It engaged in a savage 51-day battle in the hills of southern Okinawa until the island was secure.

Private Mitschke entered the Army last June and was stationed at Fort Bliss, Texas, before his present overseas assignment.
