

Lee 4-H Members Enter Texas Hybrid Corn Area Contest

Four 4-H Club members in Lee County have made plans to take part in the 1953 Texas Hybrid Corn Contest, according to Brown O. Spivey, Lee County agent.

The four entries from Lee County are Marvin Arldt of the Manheim club, and John Kalmbach, T. G. Moerbe Jr., and Victor Schubert of the Fedor club.

The contest is open not only to all 4-H club members, but also to all FFA members, and all farmers in Lee County, Mr. Spivey pointed out. Other entries may still be pending.

Entries from Lee County will compete in Area 3 for prizes of \$50.00, \$35.00, \$25.00, \$10.00, and \$5.00.

Rules governing the contest are:

1. Each individual must enroll with his county agent;
2. He must plant at least one acre in his contest plot.
3. One of the following Texas Hybrid strains must be used for seed: 18, 24, 26, 28, 30, 9W, 11W, or 15W.
4. A brief report must be furnished the county agent, showing yield, number of the hybrid planted, and fertilizers used.
