

Voters to Choose Trustees, Mayor, Commissioners

Names Appearing on Ballots Are Listed: All Eligible Voters Urged to Participate

Voters are reminded of the important local elections coming up this Saturday and next Tuesday.

Saturday, April 1 is school trustee election day in the common and independent school districts of the county.

Tuesday, April 4 is the day set for the election of two commissioners and a mayor for the City of Giddings to serve for two-year terms.

Common school trustees are to be elected in each of the common school districts in the county and in the independent districts of Giddings and Lexington. One trustee is to be elected in each of the common districts except Tanglewood where the number is two, Dime Box seven, and Post Oak three.

County trustees are to be elected in Precincts 1 and 2.

Three trustees are to be elected in the Giddings Independent district.

Two trustees are to be elected in the Lexington Independent district.
