

Saturday Is School Trustee Election Day in All Districts

Saturday, April 2 is school trustee election day.

Elections will be held in the Giddings Independent School District and in the common school districts in the county.

In the Giddings district two vacancies created by the expired terms of H. C. Carleston and Fred O. Placke are to be filled. Both of these men are candidates for re-election.

Elections will be held in the common districts as follows: Fedor, two to be elected, none filed; Dime Box, two to be elected, Elder Burttschell and Gerh. Klasman filed; Doak Springs, one to be elected, David Crittendon filed.

Also, Post Oak, seven to be

lected, Shelly Branch, Winston Gantt, Ira Harris, L. R. Ruffin, T. D. McCoy, L. V. Colvin, Ira Jarmon, S. L. Oliver, Onnie Ray, Mickle Hancock, John Punchard, Luther Huff, George Jackson Jr., L. C. Oliver, and Lem Mack filed.

Also, Fairview, one to be elected, Jesse Taylor and Fred Lacy filed; Moab, one to be elected, Lee Parks filed.

Voters in the county also will elect a county trustee-at-large for which position C. A. Hamff, incumbent, has filed, and county trustees in Commissioners Precinct 3 where Calvin Sanders, incumbent, has filed, and in Commissioners Precinct 4 where Albert Schuhmann, incumbent, has filed for re-election.

Polling places will be open from 8 a. m. to 7 p. m. Saturday.
