DISTRICT COURT

District court closed Wednesday with the conviction of Jose Colangue for assault with intent to murder. He was given a five year sentence in the penitentiary. He stole some hosiery from Henry Lehman and when Lehman followed him on the street, the Mexican drew a razor and threatened him.

Tom McNeill was given a 2-year suspended sentence for stealing a turkey.

Mexican "Shorty" was tried for disposing of stolen cigarettes, but was acquitted by a jury.

One minor case will be called Monday, but no jury will be needed. All other criminal cases were continued until the October term.

A light civil docket was had this term of court.

The widow of Erich Baack who was killed by a train near Lampasas, was given \$500 by agreement with counsel for the railroad.
