**ATTENTION,  
MEN OF DRAFT AGE**

Those persons who are in the draft age and above 28 years old are required to keep their local board advised of any change in address. While such persons are not being called at present time, they are subject to call should an emergency arise.

Young men who were subject to draft Oct. 16, 1940 or July 1, 1941 and who have enlisted in the service, and are later discharged, are required to register with their local board, unless they are already registered. Because a man has served a year and is released, does not exempt him from further service if an emergency arises.
