ELECTION**

The result of the school trustee election held Saturday April 2 for the Giddings school district was:

E. M. Collier	80
Oscar Winkler	76
George Southernwood	70

These were the only names on the ballot.

CITY ELECTION

The election held Tuesday for City of Giddings officials resulted in a new city commission being elected, as follows:

J. S. Hillsman (incumbent)	170
E. H. Moellenberndt	235
Commissioners (two elected)	
G. H. Fritsche (incumbent)	199
Edward Sinks	153
Henry Lehman	236
Wm. Mueller	202

The commission was composed of Mayor Hillsman and Commissioner Fritsche, as there was one vacancy. The heaviest vote in years was polled, 409 ballots being cast.
