

Election Contest Hearing Reset Friday Morning

Hearing of the contest of the results of the voting for Commissioner in Precinct No. 2 in the July Democratic Primary has been reset for Friday morning, Aug. 18.

The hearing originally had been set for Tuesday morning but District Judge John H. Tate postponed the case until Friday.

Aug. O. Zoch Jr., loser in the primary by one vote — 366 to 367, contested the election of Oscar W. Urban to the office.

Mr. Zoch filed a petition in District Court alleging that a voter had voted without having paid a poll tax, with the voter's affidavit to that effect attached to the petition.

An amendment to the original petition was filed later. The contestee, Mr. Urban, made objection to this amendment, stating that he had not had sufficient time to study the amendment. District Judge Tate sustained the objection and postponed the case until Friday.

Mr. Zoch is represented by Ted Simmang and Mr. Urban by C. C. Jopling of La Grange.
