

## Future Farmers Receive Ribbons On Fair Entries

Forty-four ribbons were received by F. F. A. students at the Lee County Fair, according to Mr. Tom Cherry, advisor.

Those winning blue ribbons in the Beef Cattle division and their entries are as follows: Edward Reinhardt, Hereford heifer; Edgar Weiser, Angus steer; Dean Stuessy, Hereford heifer (Reserve Grand Champion); Earl Mueller, Hereford bull (Reserve Grand Champion).

In the dairy division Edgar Weiser won a blue ribbon for his Jersey Cow (Grand Champion).

Allan Marburger won a first in the sheep division with two rams and a second on ewes.

The poultry division all won

first prizes. They are as follows: Clarence Menzel, 3 geese; Walter Arldt, Turkey Tom (Grand Champion), pen of 3 turkeys, turkey hens, and turkey tom.

The vegetable division had one person who entered: David Riffe won a first with 6 sweet potatoes. A cluster of 3 sweet potatoes won him a first, second, and third place and a cluster of squash won him a first.

Those winning red ribbons and their entries are as follows: Dairy Divisions: Earl Mueller, Holstein; Bobby Faske, Jersey Heifer; Hog Division: Earl Mueller, 1 hog; Sheep Division: Allan Marburger, ram; Poultry Division: William Arldt, trio of turkeys.

Those winning third and fourth prizes are as follows: Elroy Geisler, Heifers (3rd); William Arldt, Hereford Heifers (4th); Earl Mueller, Hereford Bull (3rd); Earl Mueller, hog (3rd).
