**LEE COUNTY INSPECTORS
APPOINTED**

H. R. Fawks, Federal supervisor of tick eradication in Lee County informs us that he has just been advised of the appointment of local tick inspectors for our county.

All of these men will start work April 1. Mr. Fawks states that the vat building program has gone on very well, however, on account of the farmers being behind with their farm work there are a good many vats where the pens have not been completed. He urges that the communities build these pens just as soon as possible in order that the work may be started on time. Delay in getting the proper start only necessitates carrying the dipping on later in the winter season when the stock are not in as good condition to dip as they will be by April 1.
